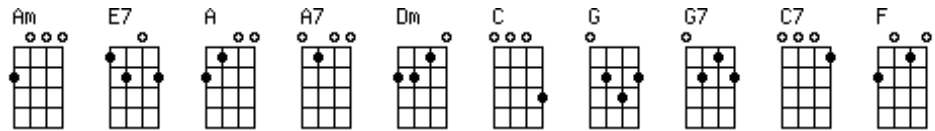


Delilah
