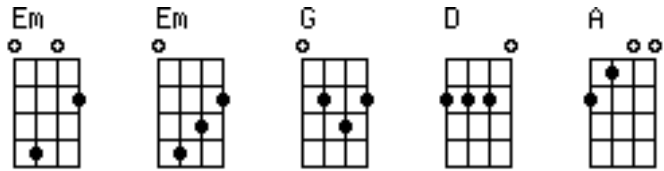


# Mad World
